Journal of the Upper House of Assembly

A General Assembly of Proclamation bearing date the tenth day of July Anno Domini 1682 appointed to begin and be holden at the City of Saint Marys the 12th day of October then next following and by Proclamation bearing date the ninth day of September 1682 prorogued unto the twenty fourth day of October then next following and from thence by Proclamation bearing date the said twenty fourth day of October further prorogued until the twenty sixth day of the same month at which said twenty sixth day of October 1682 the said Assembly met and sat at the said City of Saint Marys and there continued until the seventeenth day of November then next following and was from thence then prorogued until the first Tuesday in March then next following and by Proclamation bearing date the three and twentieth day of January 1682 prorogued unto the eighth day of May then next following and by Proclamation bearing date the third day of April Anno Domini 1683 was prorogued unto the fourth day of September then next following and by Proclamation bearing date the sixth day of July Anno Domini 1683 was further prorogued unto the first Tuesday in October following to meet at the Ridge in Anne Arundel County at which said first Tuesday in October last past the said Assembly met and sat at the said Ridge in Anne Arundel County and there continued until the 6th day of Jan. last past and was from thence adjourned unto the first day of April and by Proclamation bearing date the 13th day of February last past appointed to sit and meet at the City of Saint Marys the said first day of April 1684 at which said day the said Assembly accordingly met at the said City of Saint Marys where appeared in the upper House viz
