I have desired them on their journey here and therefore request that under your Excellency
is established there well so far regard the Places of his Places not to countenance or carry
of those or other Indians belonging to this his majestys Colonies that shall depart from
their respective Places allotted them without the consent thereof and who so ever give
all free liberty that shall be deemed convenient from now henceforth to pass and re-
standing which has formerly been denied.

For these Reasons we are of Opinion that the present Rangers may be lessened in
Number from twelve to eight under the command of Captain Duran who is now there
and such a Lieutenant as your Excellency shall appoint to keep the Country ready
Ranging by a Party at a time till further Orders

Whereupon his Excellency is Pleaseed to affre the Gentlemen of his Council to serve
his Majestys Good of this Province his Excellency understanding that the House
of Delegates were met was pleased to send the Honourable Col: Henry Jones and Thomas
Tonck Esq to have M^r Christopher Gregory sworn Clerk of the House of Delegates

Who returned and say that they did present Mr Gregory to the House to have him
sworn and that the House did accept of and approve him but refused to swear him in and
he took also an Oath of Secrecy which they say is usual

Colonel Courts and Col: Frisby sent for M^r Speaker and the House of Delegates to attend
his Excellency the Governor in Council. Who came up and being admitted

His Excellency was pleased to acquaint them that forasmuch as it hath pleased Almighty
God of his Great Mercy to bless his Majestys Kingdoms and Dominions with many Great
and Signal Blessings particularly by turning his Glory and endeavours with an honourable
and happy Peace the safe return of his Majesty to his Kingdom in quietty and the happy
Union and signall agreement accord between his Majesty and Parliament in raising such
Supplies as were necessary for defraying Armes and supporting the Honour and Dignity
of the Crown. And what in a more peculiar and never manner affected this his Majestys
Province in God Almighies withdrawing his affliction Hand of sickness from us and restoring
Health to us and Blessing us with several Beneficial and healing Springs of Water
Called the hot Springs which by his Blessing have wrought many wonderful and signal
Cures amongst several distempred and Impotent Persons and lastly for that the late Com-
motions false Rumours were created and distinguished he had appointed Tuesday next
being the 25th Instant to be set apart for a day of publick Thanksgiving and Rejoycing
therefore to be kept and observed by the General Assembly and others at the Town and
Port of Annapolis and the 22nd of November next An Arundell County and all other
Counties within this Province

His Excellency is pleased to Communicate and read their lordships letter of the 21st of
the Lords of the Colonial Trade and Foreign Plantations Letter to him of the 21st of
March 169^{1/2} with an Inclosed Copy of an Act of Assembly made lately in pursuance
for Supressing of Pyrates and Sea Robbers and recommends to the House that they would
consider to make such a law within this Province

Also his Excellency reads to the House their lordships letter to them concerning their
Agent for this Province and the having a few Transcripts of the Body of Law now
in force Transcribed and Translated to them which he recommends to the
