

- No. 38. A supplement to the act, entitled, An act to vest certain powers in the governor and council.
- No. 39. An act to provide for the collection of taxes due in Anne Arundel county, and for other purposes.
- No. 40. An act for the relief of certain purchasers of confiscated property.
- No. 41. An act to settle and pay the civil list, and other expences of civil government.
- No. 42. An act to alter such parts of the constitution and form of government as prevent a citizen from taking a seat in the legislature, or being an elector of the senate, without taking an oath to the support of this government.
- No. 43. An act to enable the inhabitants of Saint-Paul's parish, in Queen-Anne's county, to elect vestrymen and churchwardens for said parish.
- No. 44. An act to dispose of the reserved lands westward of Fort Cumberland, in Washington county, and to fulfil the engagements made by this state to the officers and soldiers of the Maryland line in the service of the United States.
- No. 45. A supplement to an act, entitled, An act authorising the appointment of trustees to sell and convey a tract of land called Hall's Lot, lying and being in Charles county, for the purposes therein mentioned.
- No. 46. An act to cede to congress a district of ten miles square in this state for the seat of the government of the United States.
- No. 47. An act to continue the acts of assembly therein mentioned, and for other purposes.
- No. 48. An act for the payment of the journal of accounts.
- No. 49. An act to empower the governor and council to compound with the discoverers of British property, and for other purposes.

The senate adjourns till the first Monday in November next.
