

VOTES AND PROCEEDINGS, November, 1789.

- No. 46. An additional supplementary act to an act, entitled, 'An act for enlarging the powers of the high court of chancery.'
- No. 47. An act concerning the debtors and creditors of this state under the act to establish funds to secure the payment of the public debt within six years, and for the punctual payment of the annual interest thereon.
- No. 48. An act respecting the miners on the reserved lands westward of Fort Cumberland.
- No. 49. An act to settle and pay the civil list, and other expences of civil government.
- No. 50. An act respecting the collectors of the public taxes since the first of January, seventeen hundred and eighty-three.
- No. 51. An act for the payment of the journal of accounts.
- No. 52. An act to continue an act, entitled, An act for the regulation of officers fees, passed at November session, seventeen hundred and seventy-nine.
- No. 53. An act to continue an act, entitled, An act concerning jurisdiction.
- No. 54. An act to continue an act, entitled, An act to declare what foreign gold and silver coin shall be deemed current money of this state, passed at November session, seventeen hundred and eighty-one.
- No. 55. An act to continue an act for repairing the public roads in this province, and the supplementary thereto.
- No. 56. An act to continue an act, entitled, An act for the more effectual punishment of certain offenders; and for the taking from them the benefit of clergy, made at a session of assembly begun and held at the city of Annapolis on the twenty-sixth day of April, seventeen hundred and thirty-seven.
- No. 57. An act to continue an act, entitled, An act to continue the acts of assembly therein mentioned, and for other purposes, passed November session, seventeen hundred and eighty-eight.
- No. 58. An act to continue the act of assembly therein mentioned.
- No. 59. An act to continue an act passed at May session, seventeen hundred and eighty-eight, entitled, An act to repeal an act, entitled, An act for the relief of insolvent debtors, and to revive another act, entitled, An act for the relief of insolvent debtors.
- No. 60. An act to continue an act, entitled, An act for the relief of insolvent debtors.
- No. 61. An act to continue an act, entitled, An act to prevent disabled and superannuated slaves being set free, or the manumission of slaves by any last will or testament; passed June session, seventeen hundred and fifty-two.
