Also, the bill to incorporate a manufacturing company in Talbot county, on the Eastern Shore of Maryland; and the bill for the benefit of James Hope, William Cariens and Robert Cariens, devisees of Thomas M'Gettogen, late of Harford county, deceased, severally endorsed, "will pass with the proposed amendments," which amendments were read, agreed to, and the bills ordered to be engrossed; and the resolution in favor of George W. Bradford; endorsed, dissented from.

Mr. Belt delivers a petition from Martha Sewell, of Anne-Arundel county, praying to be supported out of the poor's-house; which was read and referred to Messrs. Belt, Marriott and A. Dorsey.

Mr. Jump delivers a bill entitled, A supplement to an act entitled, An act to direct the register of wills of Caroline county to keep his office in Denton, in said county, and there to deposit the record books and papers belonging to said office; and Mr. C. Dorsey delivers a bill entitled, An act supplementary to the act entitled, An act concerning marriages; which were read.
