WEDNESDAY, DECEMBER 25, 1811.

THE House met.—Present the same members as on yesterday. The proceedings of yesterday were read.

Mr. Lewis Duvall delivers a bill entitled, An act to incorporate the charitable society of the city of Annapolis. Mr. Ennails delivers a bill entitled, An act to authorise any debtor and his creditor to enter up judgment before the clerk of any county court where the debtor shall reside during the recess of the county court. Mr. Groome delivers a bill entitled, An act to authorise Owen Evans, guardian of the heirs at law of Jesse Brooks, deceased, to sell and convey certain lands therein mentioned, lying in Cecil county. Mr. Howard delivers a bill entitled, An act authorising the executors of Mary Yellott, to release certain mortgages therein mentioned; and Mr. Emory delivers a bill entitled, An act to appoint Thomas Seegar, of Queen Anne's county, trustee, to convey to John Price, certain lands therein mentioned; which were severally read.

The report in favor of Alexander Dent, was read the second time and the question put, That the house assent to the resolution therein contained? Determined in the negative.

Mr. Street delivers the following report:

THE Committee to whom was referred the petition of John M'Comas, of Harford county, Report, That the relief prayed for is given to the petitioner by the act to incorporate a company to erect toll-bridges across Winter's run, in Harford county, and the Big and Little falls in Baltimore county.
