FRIDAY, DECEMBER 27, 1811.

THE House met.—Present the same members as on yesterday.—The proceedings of yesterday were read.

The bill to tax bank-stock and other monied institutions within this state, was sent to the senate.

Mr. Emory delivers a bill entitled, An act authorising Philemon C. Blake, late sheriff of Queen Anne's county to complete his collection.

Mr. Swearingen delivers a bill entitled, A supplement to an act to ascertain and provide for the payment of certain damages sustained by John Logsdon and others of Frederick county; and Mr. Randall delivers a bill entitled, An act to empower Caroline Zollickoffer of Frederick county, to exchange and lease out certain grounds in Baltimore county therein mentioned; which were severally read.

On motion of Mr. Randall, Leave given to bring in a bill entitled, An act to provide for the straightening part of the Philadelphia post-road, near the city of Baltimore. *Ordered*, That Messrs. Randall, Harryman and Brown be a committee to prepare and bring in the same. Mr. Randall delivers the said bill; which was read.

On motion by Mr. C. Dorsey the question was put, That the house reconsider the bill vesting a right of dower in Elizabeth Hodges, in the property therein mentioned, and for others purposes? Resolved in the affirmative. On motion by Mr. F. Hall, *Ordered*, that the same be recommitted.

Mr. Marriott delivers a bill entitled, An act for the benefit of William Davis and Elizabeth Davis, of Anne-Arundel county; which was read.

The report on the petition of the elders and congregation of the Wicomico Presbyterian church, was read the second time and concurred with.

Mr. Marriott delivers the following report:
