

Also, a bill entitled, an act to incorporate the stockholders of the Temascaltepec Mining Company of Baltimore, which was read the first time, and referred to Messrs. Heath, Johnson and Thomas.

Also, a bill entitled, an act to divorce Henrietta Hewitt and her husband William Hewitt, of the city of Baltimore, which was read the first time, and referred to the committee on divorces.

Also, a bill entitled, a further supplement to the act entitled, an act for the recovery of small debts out of court, and to repeal the acts of assembly therein mentioned, which was read the first time.

Mr. Sewell, from the committee on divorces, reported a bill entitled, an act for the relief of Elizabeth Gibson, of Harford county, which was read the first and by special order a second time.

The senate adjourned until Monday morning 10 o'clock.

Monday, February 5th, 1827.

The Senate met. Present the same members as on Saturday, except Mr. Lloyd, Prest. and Mr. Whiteley.

The president being absent, the senate proceeded to the election of a president pro tem. The ballots being deposited in the ballot box, on examination thereof, it appeared that William H. Marriott, Esq. was elected, and he was accordingly declared president of the senate pro. tem. The proceedings of Saturday were read.

Mr. Heath asked and obtained leave of absence for Mr. Lloyd, Prest. and Mr. Harrison, asked and obtained leave of absence for Mr. Whiteley.

The clerk of the house of delegates delivered a resolution in favour of Margaret Bomgardener, of Washington county, and a resolution in favour of Mary Ann Kershner of Alleghany county, which were read the first time, and referred to the committee on pensions and revolutionary claims.

Also, a bill to divorce William Scott and Anne Maria Scott of the city of Baltimore, which was, read the first time, and referred to the committee on divorces.

Also, a bill entitled, an act relating to the proceedings of the levy court of Baltimore county, which was read the first time.

Mr. Johnson, from the committee, reported a bill entitled, an act relating to manumissions, which was read the first time, and ordered to be printed.

On motion by Mr. Dennis, the report of the committee to whom was referred, the bill for the relief of Henrietta Maria
