Also, a bill entitled, an act to enable Charles Carroll, of Carrolton, to receive patents for two warrants of re-survey on lands in Baltimore county, heretofore conveyed in trust by him, which was read the first time, and referred to Messrs. Heath, Nelson, and Forrest.

Also, a bill entitled, an act to authorise Mary E. M'Donough, of Kent county, to remove negro Jane, into this state, which was read the first time.

Also, a bill entitled, an act to repeal and alter all such part of the constitution, and form of government as relates to the division of Baltimore county, into election districts which was read the first time, and referred to Messrs. Heath, Nelson and Thomas.

Also, a bill entitled, an act to give the levy court of Caroline county, certain discretionary powers therein mentioned which was read the first time, and referred to Messrs. Whiteley, Nelson and Rees.

Also, a bill entitled, an act to divorce Theodore Kimmel and Elizabeth Kimmel, his wife of the city of Baltimore, which was read the first time, and referred to the committee on divorces.

Also, a bill entitled, an act to make valid and effectual the letter of attorney therein mentioned, which was read the first time, and referred to the committee on invalid deeds.

Also, a bill entitled, an act to provide for altering the grade of Fayette street, in the city of Baltimore, between Paca and Cove streets, which was read the first time.

Also, a bill entitled, an act to open and extend pine street, in the city of Baltimore, which was read the first time.

Also a bill entitled, an act to make public a road therein mentioned, which was read the first time.

Also, a bill entitled, an act incorporating the masters and wardens of Clinton Lodge, number eighty-three of free and accepted Masons, for the purposes therein mentioned, which was read the first time.
