Mr. Heath from the committee to whom was referred, the bill relating to certain property of Rebecca Smith, of Baltimore county, reported the same with the proposed amendment, which amendment was read and assented to. The said bill as amended was then passed and returned to the house of delegates.

Mr. Heath, made a favourable report upon the bill, to authorise Rachael Colvin and Samuel Colvin, of the city of Baltimore, to execute deeds for certain property therein described.—The said bill was then read a third time, passed and returned to the house of delegates.
