

a law to incorporate a company by the name of the Neptune Insurance Company, which was read the first time, and referred to Messrs. Heath, Lloyd and Nelson.

Mr. Whiteley from the committee to whom was referred the bill, entitled, a supplement to the act, entitled, an act for building a bridge on the north west fork of the Nanticoke river, in Caroline county, at or near a place called and known by the name of the "old Bloomery," and for other purposes therein named, passed at December session, 1826, reported, that the committee had had the same under consideration, and were of opinion that it ought to pass with the following amendment, viz: after the word "them" in the 3d line of the first section, add "if the Levy court of Caroline county, or a majority of said court, shall think it a desirable;" which amendment was read and assented to. The bill was then read a second and by special order a third time, passed with the proposed amendment and returned to the House of Delegates.
