

**Agent's account of the debts due the state of Maryland on the eastern shore.**

**John Creswell and securities**

John Creswell is dead, and his estate is insolvent. His administrator has paid part of the debt, and this balance is still due. Judgments were obtained against securities, September, 1815. The land of one of the securities has been sold under a judgment of later date than that of the state. The agent has ordered sci. fa. against terre-tenants, and hopes still to recover the balance

**George W. Lightner and securities**

Judgments in 1816. The agent has ordered sci. fa. against principal and securities, and has reason to believe part, if not the whole of this debt will be recovered.

**William Chambers and securities**

755 10

Judgments against securities. Executions issued and property levied on. This case has been under a stay by the legislature. Since the stay expired agent has received 300 dollars from one of the securities. The balance is secure, and agent is using the necessary means to recover it.

**William Waller**

790 41

For this debt the bond of George Dashiell, former sheriff of Somerset county, has become liable. Judgments against Dashiell and securities, Nov. 1826. No part of this debt has yet been collected. The agent thinks it secure, and has reason to believe it will be collected during the course of the present year.

**Robert C. Lusby, and securities**

800 00

This balance is due from Mr. Lusby, a former sheriff of Cecil county. He paid agent last year 250, and will pay this balance, agent believes, this year. The executions will be renewed to the next court.

**William S. Handy and securities**

2 500 00

Judgments were obtained against William S. Handy and securities, May 1820. For some time further proceedings were suspended by the legislature. An inconsiderable part of the original debt has been paid. The agent, since his appointment, has made every exertion to collect
