Also a bill entitled, a supplement to an act entitled, an act to amend and reduce into one, the several acts of assembly, relating to the public roads in Worcester county, passed at December session, 1821, chapter 110; which was read the first time and referred to Messrs. Dennis, Harrison and Rees.

Also, a bill entitled, an act authorising the orphans' court of Cecil county, to appoint a guardian to sell and convey the property of Allen Wilson; which was read the first time and referred to Messrs. Heath, Lloyd and Sewell.

Also a bill entitled, an act to fix the compensation of supervisors of the public roads in Prince Georges county; which was read the first time.

Also, a bill entitled, an act to alter the present mode of appointing the justices of the Levy court of Dorchester county, so that each election district may have one member; which was read the first time and referred to Messrs. Whiteley, Thomas and Harrison.

The resolution providing for the re-payment of certain monies paid into the treasury, under the act of December session, 1821, chapter 246, upon certain conditions; was read a second and by special order a third time, assented to and returned to the house of delegates.

Mr. Heath from the committee reported a bill entitled, a supplement to the act entitled, an act to amend and reduce into one system, the laws directing descents, which was read the first time.

Mr. Heath asked and obtained leave to bring in a bill to be entitled, an act relating to the use of foreign law books in the courts of this state. Ordered, that Messrs. Heath, Harrison and Herbert be a committee to prepare and report the same.

Mr. Nelson from the committee to whom was referred the resolution relating to internal improvement, and the Chesapeake and Ohio Canal, made a favourable report up-
