

bidder for cash, after having given twenty days previous notice of the time and place of said sale, by advertisement in one of the public prints published in the town of Cambridge, or set up at the court house door of said county, or otherwise dispose of the same according to their discretion for the use of the said county; and the person so purchasing under this act, shall be entitled to sue for and recover the debt or accounts so purchased in the name of the levy court of said county.

Which amendments were read and rejected; the said bill was then read a second and by special order a third time; rejected and returned to the house of delegates.

Mr. Johnson presented the petition of Charles Carroll of Carrollton and others, praying the passage of an act to annul the location of a high way on the east side of Jones Falls between east Baltimore street and east water street, in the city of Baltimore, or that if said location is to remain, that the petitioners as property holders on said high way may be paid for that part of their property embraced by said high way, agreeably to the 16th section of the act of 1817 as was built upon prior to the passage of the said act, which was read and referred to Messrs. Johnson, Lloyd and Herbert.

The clerk of the house of delegates delivered a bill entitled, an act to promote education in Frederick, which was read the first time, and referred to Messrs. Nelson, Forrest and Sewell.

Also a bill entitled, an act to incorporate the Elkton and Susquehanna Bridge turnpike company, which was read the first time, and referred to the committee on internal improvement.

The bill to authorise the several courts in this state to appoint surveyors in certain cases was read a second time.

The supplement to the act entitled, an act to amend and reduce into one system the laws directing descents, was read a third time, amended on motion of Mr. Heath, passed with the proposed amendments, and sent to the house of delegates.

Amendments proposed. 1st. In the 3d line of the 1st section, strike out the words "either of them," and insert the words "majority of such commissioners." 2nd. Strike out the word "commissioners," in the 5th line.

3d. In the 1st line of the 2nd section strike out the word "and" and insert in lieu thereof before the words
