

On motion of Mr. Heath, the further supplement to an act to incorporate a company to make a turnpike road, to lead from the cross roads, near Richard Caton's lime kiln, in Baltimore county nearly in the direction of Jones' Falls to the city of Baltimore, was ordered to be printed.

The Senate adjourned until to-morrow morning ten o'clock.

Wednesday, February 13th, 1828.

The senate met. Present the same members as on yesterday.

The proceedings of yesterday were read.

The bill for the relief of Washington Lucas of Washington county, was read a second time, and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

On motion of Mr. Nelson, the further supplement to the act for amending and reducing into system, the laws and regulations concerning last wills and testaments, the duties of executors, administrators and guardians, and the rights of orphans and other representatives of deceased persons, was ordered to lie on the table.

The bill to incorporate the Elkton and Susquehanna Bridge Turnpike Company, was read a third time.

Mr. Nelson moved to amend the same by inserting the words "government of the," before the words "United States," in the 2d line of the 9th section, so as to authorise the Government of the United States to become a stockholder in the company incorporated by the bill, and the question was put, and determined in the affirmative.

Mr. Nelson moved to strike out the words "or any of the secretaries of any of the departments of the United States," in the 2d and 3d line of the 9th section, and the question was put, and determined in the affirmative.

Mr. Lloyd moved to strike out the words "any corporate body of," in the 1st line of the 9th section, and after some discussion the bill and amendment, on motion of Mr. Johnson, was ordered to lie on the table.

Mr. Heath from the committee, reported a bill entitled, a supplement to the act entitled, an act to provide for electing commissioners for Baltimore county, and prescribing their powers and duties, passed at December session 1826 chapter 217, which was read the first time, and ordered to be printed.
