

The clerk of the house of delegates delivered a resolution in favor of Washington Hall, of Cecil county, which was read the first time, and referred to the committee on ways and means.

Mr. Sewell from the committee, reported a bill entitled a further supplement to the act entitled, an act to incorporate a company to make the several turnpike roads therein mentioned, passed at December session eighteen hundred and fifteen. chapter one hundred and ninety, which was read the first time, and ordered to be printed.

On motion of Mr. Heath, the senate proceeded to the election of a director on the part of the state, in the bank of Baltimore.

Mr. Heath nominated William Dickinson, Esq.

The ballot box being prepared, the ballots were deposited therein, and on examination thereof by the clerk, it appeared that William Dickinson, Esq. received thirteen votes, being the whole number of votes given. Whereupon it was declared in the senate, that William Dickinson, Esq. was unanimously elected a director on the part of the state, in the bank of Baltimore.

The clerk of the house of delegates delivered a resolution relative to the record of certain papers and proceedings of the court of chancery, which was read the first, and by special order a second and third time, and assented to.

Also, a bill entitled, an act relative to tobacco remaining in the several tobacco warehouses, and the manner of issuing manifests and writs in this state; which was read the first time, and referred to Messrs. Herbert, Thomas and Kennedy.

Also, a bill entitled, an act relative to the inspection of tobacco, which was read the first time, and referred to Messrs. Herbert, Thomas and Whiteley.

The senate adjourned until to-morrow morning 9 o'clock.

The resolution relative to the records of certain papers and proceedings in the court of chancery, yesterday assented to by the senate, was returned to the house of delegates.
