Add, to the title, the words "and to incorporate the same."

In the 3d line of the 1st section, strike out the word "third," and insert "first;" and, in the same line and section, strike out the word "February," and insert "May;" and after the word "next," in the 4th line of said section, insert, "and on the same day in every year thereafter."
