

Strike out the 3d section.

Strike out the 4th section.

After the word "town" in the 3d line of the 5th section, insert "The election to be held at the court-house in said town, and the polls to be kept open from nine o'clock in the morning until four in the afternoon."

In the 3d and 4th lines of the 5th sections, strike out "or in case no justice should attend, by any two persons selected by the voters of said town."

After the word "same," at the end of the 4th line of the 5th section, insert "shall conduct the said election in the same manner in which the judges of an election district are now by law directed to hold an election for delegates to the Assembly, and."

After the word "who," at the end of the 5th line of the 5th section, insert "shall have the said election returns recorded in their proceedings, and the said councilmen."

In the third line of the 6th section, strike out the word "above," and insert "to."

In the 4th line of the 6th section, after the word "taxation," insert "as valued in the county assessment."

At the end of the 8th section, strike out the words, "and hereby made perpetual."

At the end of the bill, add,

"Section 9. And be it enacted, That the act to which this is a supplement, and the act entitled, An act to provide for the appointment of commissioners for the regulation and improvement of the town of Cumberland, in Allegany county, and to incorporate the same, which passed at December session, 1815, chapter 136, be, and the same are hereby revived, and declared to be in full force, except so far as the said acts are amended and changed by this act."

The bill was then read the second, and by special order the third time, passed, and returned to the House of Delegates.

The clerk of the House of Delegates delivered a resolution in favor of John C. Derickson,

Which was read the first time, and referred to the committee on finance.
