Leave was granted to Messrs. Mayer, Montgomery and Hughlett, to prepare and report a bill to be entitled, a supplement to the act entitled, an act to authorise limited partnerships within this state, passed at December session 1825, chapter 113.

The Senate adjourned until to-morrow morning 10 o'clock.
