

Which was read the first time and referred to the committee on judicial proceedings.

A bill entitled, an act to authorize the extension of a street in the village of Port Deposit, Cecil county, to connect the same with the public road,

Which was read the first time and referred to Messrs. Groome, Wilson and Claude,

A bill entitled, an act to lay out and open a road through part of Frederick and Baltimore counties,

Which was read the first time and referred to Messrs. Sappington, Mayer and Morris.

A bill entitled, a supplement to an act entitled, an act for the re-valuation of the real and personal property in Frederick county,

Which was read the first time and referred to Messrs. Sappington, Emory and Pigman.

A bill entitled, an act to authorize the register of the land office of the Western Shore, to issue a warrant or warrants of resurvey and patent for certain lands lying in Allegany county,

Which was read the first time and referred to Messrs. Pigman, Emory and Claude.

And returned the bill which originated in the Senate, entitled, an act relating to the jurisdiction and powers now vested in justices of the peace for the city of Baltimore, endorsed "will pass with the proposed amendments,

Which were read and were as follows:

Strike out the word "March" in the first line of section 1, and insert May.

Same section, in the second line, strike out the words "three years" and insert "year."

In the second section, second line, strike out "three years" and insert "a year."

Add as an additional section, the following:

"Section 11. And be it enacted, That the Governor and Council, in the commissions, to the Aldermen respectively, shall designate the particular ward of the city of Baltimore, in which such Alderman shall hold his place of official business, and it shall be the duty of such Alderman, accordingly, to hold his place of business aforesaid, in such designated ward."

Also returned the bill which originated in the Senate, entitled, an additional supplement to the act entitled, an act to incorporate the American Life Insurance and Trust Company, endorsed "will pass with the proposed amendments,
