It was ordered, that the clerk cause copies to be made of the act entitled, an additional supplement to an act entitled, an act to encourage internal improvement, and

The act entitled, a supplement to an act entitled, an act to encourage internal improvement, which severally passed the Legislature during the present session, and that they be printed for the use of the Senate.

The bill entitled, a further supplement to the act entitled, an act directing the manner of suing out attachments in this Province and limiting the extent of them, was read the second time, and

On motion of Mr. Groome,

Amended as follows:

Add the following sections to the bill:

Sec. 3. And be it enacted, that in all cases hereafter, when a Sheriff shall take goods and chattels, lands or tenements, in virtue of any writ of attachment, and there shall afterwards be a judgment of condemnation thereon, any execution which shall be issued on such judgment, shall be directed to the same person who levied the attachment, if he be living in the county when such goods and chattels, lands and tenements were taken, whether his term of office shall have expired or not, and it shall be his duty to execute the same.

Sec. 4. And be it enacted, That the official bond of such Sheriff for the year in which the attachment shall be levied, shall be liable for any default in executing such process of attachment or execution, and that such Sheriff shall receive poundage fees but once for executing such attachment and execution.

The bill was then ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

Mr. Groome from the committee to which was referred the bill entitled, an act relating to constables fees for Cecil county, and for other purposes, reported that the committee had had said bill under consideration and were of opinion it ought to pass with the following amendments,
