It was read the second, and by special order the third time, rejected, and returned to the house of delegates.

Mr. Wilson from the committee to which was referred the bill entitled, an act for the building a bridge over a stream across the road leading from Salisbury to Dirickson's Cross Roads, in Worcester county, reported favorably thereon.

It was read the second and by special order the third time, passed and returned to the house of delegates.

Mr. Wootton from the committee on internal improvement, to which was referred the resolution authorizing the appointment of certain assistants to the State's Topographical Engineer, reported that the committee had had said resolution under consideration and were of opinion it ought not to be assented to.

It was read the second time.

Mr. Wootton from the committee on internal improvement, to which was referred the resolution requiring the State's Topographical Engineer to make certain surveys, reported favorably thereon.

It was read the second and by special order the third time, assented to and returned to the house of delegates.
