

right and justice to be done in all cases civil  
whereon suit or damage is demanded according  
to the laws or laudable usages of this Province  
or otherwise according to the laws or laudable us-  
ages of England in the same or the like causes as near  
as he or they shall be able to judge and shall try all  
the same cases and shall command and  
appoint all power and means necessary or conve-  
nient thereunto and the said Lieutenant General  
and Commander shall take an oath to administer  
an equal Justice to all persons without favour  
Malice or anyone

The Lieutenant General or any one of the  
Council within the Province and the Comman-  
der of the Isle of Kent within that Island  
shall or may use command and appoint all pow-  
er and means necessary in conformity to the ap-  
pointing of Jelous or the keeping of the peace and  
the said Lieutenant General and Council shall or  
may try and Censure all Offenders within their pur-  
view whom they shall think the Offence to deserve  
except that in crimes extending to taking away  
of life or member the offender shall be first arraigned  
and afterwards tried by twelve freemen at the least  
and the Commander of the Isle of Kent shall or  
may try and Censure all Offenders within that  
Island without corporal shame and punishment  
not extending to life or member as he shall think  
the Offence to deserve and every one of the Coun-  
cil shall take an oath to defend and maintain
