 and engaging many innocent people in that his  
 wicked designs of overthrowing the Govern<sup>mt</sup>. there  
 writing he may have cause to seeme to repent but as to  
 the good will of the people which was seduced by  
 him we have given order to our said deare Brother  
 upon their timely submission and assurance of their  
 hearty sorrow for being so seduced and of their future  
 fidelity and good service to us and our Govern<sup>mt</sup>  
 there to pardon them your selves only excepted whom  
 he shall find did take therein more out of malice  
 than ignorance and with the same spirit and design  
 as Wendall himselfe did given under our hand and  
 Great Seale at Orono. the fourth day of  
 September in the ninth and twentieth years of our  
 Dominion over Maryland the first year of our  
 Lord God one thousand six hundred and sixty
