At an Assembly begun and held at the City of Annapolis the 28th Day of October in the Eleventh year of the Reign of our Sovereign Lady ANN. by the Grace of God of Great Brittain France and Ireland and the Dominions thereunto belonging QUEEN Defender of the faith &c. Anno Domini 1712 By Vertue of her Majestys Writs of Election directed to the severall and respective Sheriffs of the severall Counties of this Province and to the Mayor Recorder and Aldermen of the City of Annapolis empowering the Freeholders of the severall Counties to elect and Choose four Deputy or Delegates for each County and the said Mayor Recorder and Aldermen to Choose two Citizens for the said City aforesaid to serve as Representatives of the severall Counties and City aforesaid, in this present Generall Assembly, which said Writs bear date the twenty seventh Day of July last past Returnable this present twenty Eighth Day of October 1712 aforesaid At which time there Assembled in the Stadt House in the City of Annapolis aforesaid in the County of Ann Arundels the severall Members following.
