An Act declaring the Division of several Counties

An Act for Advancement of Vessels & Residents &c.

An Act for regulating the Militia

An Act for Payment of Criminals &c.

An Act for causing Jurors & Witnesses to come to Court

An Act for Prosecution of Harbours &c.

An Act declaring an Act Entituled an Act ascertaining the Bounds of Land to be in force

An Act for rebuilding the Stadt House

An Act declaring an Act for erecting Ann Arundel & Oxford Towns into Town & Ports to be in force

An Act declaring an Act for punishing Offences for bringing Witnesses to be in force

An Act declaring an Act for sanctifying & keeping holy the Lords Day to be in force

An Act suspending the Prosecution of Jesuits &c.

An Act for Division of St. Pauls Parish in Prince Georges County

An Act declaring the Act concerning ^{the} Indians to be in force

An Act declaring several Acts formerly made to be in force

To which his Excellency was pleased on her Majesty's behalf to give his Assent by indorsing each separately And being so indorsed his Excellency was further pleased to seal each separate Law with the Great Seal. And then his Excellency acquainted Mr. Speaker & the rest of the Members that he thought it convenient by Advice of her Majesty's Council for her Majesty's Service to prorogue them until Day of next At which Time if there be no Occasion of their meeting he would after give them timely Notice as have been usually done. And thereupon Mr. Speaker and the rest of the Members were prorogued accordingly.
