At an Assembly begun and hold

at the City of Annapolis on the 20th Day of October in the Eleventh Year of the Reign of our Sovereign Lady Ann. by the Grace of God of Great Britain France and Ireland and the Dominions thereunto belonging Queen Defender of the Faith &c. Anno Domini 1712 by Virtue of her Majesty's Writs of Election directed to the several and respective Sheriffs of the several Counties of this Province. And to the Mayor Recorder and Aldermen of the City of Annapolis empowering the Freeholders of the several Counties to elect and choose four Deputies or Delegates for each County and the said Mayor Recorder and Aldermen to choose two Citizens for the City aforesaid to serve as Representatives of the several Counties and City aforesaid in this present General Assembly which said Writs bear Date the twenty seventh Day of July last past returnable this present twenty Eighth Day of October 1712 aforesaid. At which Time there assembled in the said House in the City of Annapolis aforesaid in the County of Ann Arundel the several Members following Viz
