Thomas Brooke Esq. and Col<sup>d</sup> William Coursey from the Upper House acquaint the Delegates that his Excellency Commands them immediately to attend him in the upper house.

The House accordingly went to attend his Excellency in the Upper house where his Excellency was pleased to Command them to return to their own house immediately to make choice of a Speaker -

After which the said Members returned and then unanimously made choice of Col<sup>d</sup> Matthew Tilghman Ward a Member returned to serve as a Delegate for Talbot County for their Speaker, who in his place disabled himself to undergo so weighty a charge and
