Resolved, That such of the Debates and Proceedings of the three Sessions of this Assembly as relate to the Government or Judicature of this Province or other material publick Affairs thereof, be Printed.

At a Session of Assembly begun and held at the City of *Annapolis* in *Annapurindel* County for the Province of *Maryland*, the ninth day of *October*, *Anno Domini* One Thousand Seven Hundred and Twenty Two.

October the 12th 1722.

IN the Motion made, That a Bill be brought in to prevent the Inconveniencies that often happen by the Quashals of Proceedings in Forcible Entries and Detainers,

Ordered, That the Committee of Laws prepare one accordingly.

October the 13th 1722.

A Bill to prevent Forcible Entries, or holding Lands and Tenements with force, was read the first Time, and ordered a second Reading on *Monday*, and in the mean Time it is ordered to lie on the Table.

October the 17th 1722.

The Bill to prevent Forcible Entries, &c. was read again, and the Question being put, Whether the Bill shall pass, or not.

It was carried in the Negative by the Majority of Votes. Thereupon the Bill is Rejected.
