N^o 1 An Act for improving the Justice of the County of Prince George's
Persons of that County any sum of Tobacco not exceeding three thousand pounds of Tobacco
to pay for the building the Court House of that said County.

N^o 2 An Act for the Continuance of Process in Baltimore County Court

N^o 3 An Act to encourage the making of Union Cloth within this Province of Maryland
a Penny of the Growth thereof.

N^o 4 An Act for the Improvement of so much Tobacco on the Topley Inhabitants
of Westminster Parish in Annapolis County as will build them a wood church
and purchase two Acres of Land to build the said Church on.

N^o 5 An Act to Supply some Defects in a Deed of Bargain and Sale from Andrew
Paylard of St. Marys County Widow to William Horney and Mary his
Wife of a Part or Portion of Ground lying in Annapolis now in the Possession
of the Honorable Charles Calvert Esq^r.

N^o 6 An Act to Record and make Valid a Deed of Bargain and Sale from James Gould
and Elizabeth his Wife to William Scott and Sarah his Wife.

N^o 7 An Act to enable the Clerk of the Provincial Court or the Clerk of Baltimore
County Court to Record a Deed of Bargain and Sale from Thomas Gibson to
James Huggins and to make the same Deed Valid.

All which the Governor passed into Law by sealing them with the Right
Honorable the Lord Proprietor's Greater Seal at Annapolis and severally thus
Indorsing them viz. July the 29th 1731

In behalf of the Right Honorable the Lord

Then the Governor with the Advice of his Lordships Council was pleased to
Prorogue this Assembly to the Nineteenth day of August Next.

Mr. Speaker with the rest of the Members of that House returned
