

Col. Ward, from the Upper House, acquaints Mr. Speaker, That the Governour requires him, and the rest of the Members of this House, to attend Him immediately in the Upper House. Mr. Speaker, and the rest of the Members of this House, went to the Upper House: And Mr. Speaker presented to the Governour, the following ingross'd Bills, viz.

An Act to adjourn the Courts of Assize, *Nisi Prius*, and Goal Delivery, Provincial Court; and to continue the Process and Proceedings of the said Courts; and also to continue the Process and Proceedings in some of the County Courts within this Province; And to enlarge the Time for taking out Executions.

An Act for the Explaining and carrying into Execution, An Act, intituled, An Act for laying out and applying Three Thousand Five Hundred Pound Current Money of Maryland, to the Uses therein mentioned.

An Act to cut off the Entail of Two Tracts of Land, in Baltimore County, the one called *Morning's Choice*, the other called *Morning's Choice Addition*: And to Entail in Lieu thereof, part of *Vulcan's Rest*, in Cecil County.

An Act for relieving sundry Inhabitants of this Province, from the Charges of Prosecutions for not burning Tobacco, pursuant to an Act of Assembly, intituled, An Act for Emitting and making Current, Ninety Thousand Pounds, Current Money of Maryland, in Bills of Credit.

An Act to Confirm the Last Will and Testament of *Rebecca Calvert*, Widow, deceased, who was the Relict and Administratrix of the Honourable *Charles Calvert*, Esq; deceased; and to enable the Executors therein named, to execute the said Testament, according to the true Intent thereof.

A Supplementary Act, to the Act, intituled, an Act laying an Imposition on Negroes, and on several sorts of Liquors imported; and, also on Irish Servants; to prevent the Importing too great a Number of Irish Papists into this Province.

An Act for Naturalization.

An Act concerning Ordinaries; and for the better Regulating of Inn-holders and Ordinary-keepers, within this Province.

An Act, empowering the Rector, Vestry-Men, and Church-Wardens, of King and Queen Parish, in St. Mary's and Charles Counties, to purchase Two Acres of Land in the said Parish, in St. Mary's County, for building a Church on: And for raising a Fund, as well to compleat the said Purchase, and Building, as to repair New-Port Church in Charles County, within the said Parish.

An Act Licensing Pedlars and Hawkers.

An Act for raising Three Pence per Hoghead, on all Tobacco to be exported, for purchasing Arms and Ammunition, for the Defence of the Province.

An Act repealing an Act, intituled, An Act against Ingrossers and Regrators.

An Act to aid the Defect in the Certificate of Acknowledgement of a certain Deed of Conveyance, made, and executed by *William Pile*, of Prince George's County, Gent. and *Elizabeth* his Wife, of the one Part; and of *Thomas Marshall*, of the County aforesaid, of the Other, of Part of Tract of Land lying in the said County, called *Carrick*.

An Act continuing and reviving the Acts therein mention'd.

An Act reviving an Act of Assembly, intituled, An Act for the Relief of Prisoners for Debr.

An Act to prevent the Injuring Harbours, within this Province; and for repealing the Acts therein mention'd.

An Act to supply some Defects in an Act, intituled, An Additional and Supplementary Act to the several Acts for the Administration of Justice in Testamentary Affairs.

An Act reviving an Act of Assembly, intituled, An Act for the Advancement of Justice: As also an Act of Assembly, intituled, A Supplementary Act to the Act for the Administration of Justice.

An Act for the continuing and reviving the several Acts therein mention'd.

An Act for the Limitation of the Time for shipping Tobacco.

An Act to confirm a Deed of Mortgage, already Recorded, from a certain *Thomas Howell*, of Kent County, to *Edward Beck*, of the said County, Attorney in Fact, for a certain *Casper Hood*.

An Act for applying the Duty of Three Pence per Hoghead, raised by the Act therein mentioned.

An Act to enable the Secretary of this Province, for the Time being, to Record and Enter the Proceedings of the Provincial Court, during the Continuance of *Vachel Denton*, in the Office of Clerk of the said Court.

An Act for taking out of the Office of Commissioners or Trustees, for Emitting Bills of Credit, the several Sums herein mentioned; and for repaying the same in the said Office, by the several Treasurers in this Province.

An Act for defraying the Publick Charges of this Province.

All which the Governor was pleased to give His Assent to, by sealing them with the Seal of the Province, &c.: And then made the following Speech.

Gentlemen, of the Upper and Lower Houses of Assembly,

The Publick Business of this Session being at an End, I, with the Advice of His Lordship's Council of State, do prorogue this Assembly, to the Third Tuesday in July next: And you are to take Notice, You are prorog'd to that Day accordingly.

Mr. Speaker, with the rest of the Members of this House, returned. Mr. Speaker re-assumed the Chair, and repeated what the Governour had done and said. Whereupon this House prorogues itself to the Third Tuesday in July next. So endeth the First Session of this Assembly, the 24th Day of April, Anno Dom' 1735.
