Hammond, from the Upper House, delivers Mr. Speaker the Bill entituled, *An Act for the Trial of all Matters of Fact in the several Counties where they have arisen or shall arise.* Indorsed, ' By the Upper House of Assembly, 24th May, 1739. Read the First Time and Ordered to lie on the Table. Signed per Order, J. Ross, Cl. Up. Ho. And thus, ' By the Upper House of Assembly, 25th May 1739. Read the Second Time, and will not Pass.

Signed per Order, J. Ross, Cl. Up. Ho. Edmund Fenings, Esq; from the Upper House, delivers Mr. Speaker the Bill entituled, *An Act for ascertaining the Gauge of Barrels for Pork and Beef, and the neat Quantity of Pork and Beef to be therein contained.* Indorsed, ' By the Upper House of Assembly, 18th May 1739. Read the First Time, and Ordered to lie on the Table.

Signed per Order, J. Ross, Cl. Up. Ho. And thus, ' By the Upper House of Assembly, 25th May 1739. Read the Second Time, and will Pass, with the following Amendments, the Gauge of the Barrels to be *Thirty one Gallons and an half*, in the 2^d Line of 2^d Page, from the Word *professing*, to the Words *set up* in 5th Line of the same Page, to be left out, and the following Words to be inserted, *that shall willingly and knowingly make or set up, or cause to be made or set up after the said nine and twentieth day of September*, in 10th Line of 5th Page, in stead of the Words *use of the County School where the Offence shall be committed*, put *Right Honourable the Lord Proprietary, his Heirs and Successors, for and towards the better Support of this Government*, in the last Line of the same Page, in stead of *three say one*; in first Line of 6th Page leave out *or any two of them*, in 2^d Line, after the Word *are* put *or any one of them is*, in 6th Line of the same Page, in stead of *them or some other three*, put *any two*.
