Gentlemen of the Upper and Lower houses of Assembly
I cannot Part with you without Assuring you of my Satisfaction for
the Readiness you have shewed in making such a provision for the subsistence
of our Troops, as I hope will be sufficient for them at this Juncture

No other business being Urgent at present, I have thought fit with
the Advice of his Lordships Council of State to Prorogue this Assembly to
the last Tuesday in March next and you are to Take Notice you are
Prorogued to that Day accordingly

Day of November in the Thirty second year of the Dominion of the right
Hon^{ble} Charles Absolute Lord and Proprietary of the Provinces of
Maryland and Avalon Lord Baron of Baltimore &crd and in the
