Name or Names, and shall also register the Estate in Lands, Tenements, and Hereditaments of every such Popist. Priest and Priests, Jesuit and Joints, in such Manner and in such Words as he or they shall, by any Writing figned by him or them respectively, defire such Clerk to register the same. Provided always, that the Parish Priest or Priests, Jesuit or Jesuits, who desire such Registry to be made, shall pay to such

Clerk his lawtal Fees for such Regulty as is abovementioned.

And be it further Enacte 4. That all and every such Popish Priest and Priests, Jesuit and Jesuits, having, at the Time of the making of this Act, any Estate in Lands, Tenements, or Hereditaments, lying and being within this Prizer of the William Three Years after the End of this Session of Assembly, by Deed or Deeds of Bargan and Sale, or other proper Conveyance or Conveyances, give, grant, bargain, fell and convey, all his and their Right, Title, Interest, Claim, Property and Demand whatsoever, of, in, and to, all and singular such I min. Tenements, and Horolitaments, subject shall be mentioned in such List, so registered as given the Design of the state of in afferent des er les Default thereof, souls forteit and lose all the Estate, Right, Title, and Interest, of, in, and to, all such Lands, Tenements, and Hereditaments, not fold or disposed of by such Popish Priest and

Priests, Jesuit and Jesuits, and which by this Act he or they ought to have sold or disposed of.

The best faither Enacted, That all and every Popish Priest and Priests, Jesuit and Jesuits, by the Authority of this Act, and from and after the passing thereof, shall be disabled and made incapable to inherit, purchaie, tike, have, or enjoy, any Manors, Lands, Tenements, Annuities, Profits, Commodities, Hereditament. Goods, Chattels, Legacies, or Sums of Money, within this Province, by Descent, Donation, Devile, or Purchate, or by any other Means whatsoever; and that all and fingular Estates, Terms and other Interest, whatibever hereafter, and after the passing of this Act, to be made, suffered, or done, to or for the Ute or Behoef of any Popish Priest and Priests, Jesuit and Jesuits, or upon any Trust or Considence mediately or immediately, to or for the Benefit or Relief of any such Popish Priest and Priests, Jesuit and Jesuits,

mall be utterly void and of none Effect, to all Intents, Constructions, and Purposes whatsoever.

And to prevent any collusive Sale and Disposition of any of the Lands, Tenements, and Hereditaments, Lehe and poileiled by any Popish Priest or Jesuit, Be it surther Enacted by the Authority aforesaid, That if any Popish Priest or Jesuit shall, after such Sale and Disposal of such Lands, Tenements, and Hereditaments, remain and be in Possession of, or receive directly or indirectly, any Rents, Issues, or Profits, of any such Lands, Tenements, and Heredicaments, directed by this Act to be fold and disposed of, the same Lands, Tenements, and Hereditaments, that shall be so possessed by any such Popish Priest or Jesuit, or whereof he shall

receive the Rents, Issues, and Profits, after such Sale as aforesaid, shall be forfeited.

And be it further Enacted, That every Popish Priest and Jesuit, now in this Province, or who shall remain and be in this Province until the next County Court, held for the County where he shall be and refide, and where he shall have registered and entered his Name and Place of Abode with the Clerk of the same County Court, shall, after such Registry and Entry as aforesaid, with such Clerk, appear in Person at such County Court, and enter into a Recognizance, with two Securities, before the Justices of the same Court, in the Sum of Five Hundred Pounds to the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietary of this Province, with Condition to the same Recognizance annexed, That he shall keep the Peace and be of good Behaviour, during the Continuance of this Act, and shall not depart this Province without the Licence of the Governor or Commander in Chief, for the Time being, first had and obtained, and in Default thereof shall forfeit and

pay the Sum of Two Hundred Pounds Currency. And be it further Enacted, That every Popish Priest and Jesuit, who shall hereaster come into this Province. thill, within one Month after his coming into the Province, give in to the Clerk of the County Court, wherein he thall happen to be or arrive, his Name and intended Place of Residence, in Writing, and shall go before some Provincial Magistrate, or Magistrates of such County Court, and enter into a Recognizance, with two Securitie, before such Magnitrate, in the Sum of Five Hundred Pounds, to the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietary of this Province, with Condition to the same Recognizance annexed, that he shall keep the Peace and be of good Behaviour, during the Continuance of this Act, and shall not depart this Province without the Licence of the Governor or Commander in Chief, for the Time being, first had and obtained; and in Default thereof shall forfeit and pay the Sum of Two Hundred Pounds Currency; and that tuch Magnirate, taking such Recognizance, shall return the same to the next County Court that shall happen for such County after the taking thereof, to be entered among the Records of the same Court; and that such Clerk, to whom the Name and intended Place of Abode of such Popith Priest and Jesuit shall be given in, shall enter the same among the Records of such County, and transmit a Certificate thereof, on the Twentyninth Day of Sprember yearly, to the Clerk of the Council, for the Time being, to be by him fafely and tectively kept. And
