RESOLVED, That Samuel Chafe, Samuel Hughes, Peregrine Lethbury, William Smith, Baltimore-town, and William Hemsley, Esquires, be, and they are hereby appointed, commissioners for this state, to meet commissioners from the States of Pennsylvania and Delaware, for the purpose of considering and digesting the most proper measures for improving the inland navigation of the river Susquehanna, and the waters communicating with it, and for effecting a navigable communication between the bays of Chesapeake and Delaware, and also to confer on any other subject which may tend to promote the commerce and mutual convenience of the said states; that any three or more of the said commissioners have authority to act, and that their proceedings be reported to the next session of the general assembly, for their examination, and adoption if approved; that the governor be requested to transmit a copy of the above resolve to the executives of the states of Pennsylvania and Delaware.

RESOLVED, That the commissioners for this state to meet commissioners from the states of Pennsylvania and Delaware, respecting the navigation of the river Susquehanna and its streams, and other purposes, be paid each thirty-seven shillings and six-pence current money per day for every day's attendance on the above service.
