A BILL, entitled,

A Supplement to an act concerning estates tail.

BE IT ENACTED, by the General Assembly of Maryland, That any person or persons, seized of any estate tail, in possession, reversion or remain der, shall have full power to devise any lands, tenements or hereditaments whereof he, she or they, shall be so seized, by such manner and form of devise as any person seized of an estate in fee-simple may, by the laws of this state, devise any lands, tenements or hereditaments, whereof such per son is seized of an estate in fee-simple; and all and every such devise, of an person or persons so seized in tail, shall be good and available, to all inten and purposes, against all and every person or persons whom the devisor mig or could debar by any mode of common recovery, or any ways or mean whatever, any law or usage to the contrary notwithstanding.
