

Anne-Arundel county; were severally taken up for consideration, read the second time, passed, and sent to the senate.

On motion by Mr. Hood, the house took up for consideration the bill, entitled, An act prescribing the duties of the several armourers of this state.

On motion by Mr. Hood, the first section of the bill was amended by filling the blank in the sixth line thereof, with the words "five thousand."

On motion by Mr. Tilghman, the second blank, in the 7th line thereof, was filled with "two thousand."

On motion by Mr. Hood; the third blank, in the eighth line, same section, was filled with "one thousand."

The said bill was then read the second time, passed, and sent to the senate.

The bill, entitled, An additional supplement to the act of December session 1827, chapter 117, entitled, An act to regulate the issuing of licenses to traders, keepers of ordinaries, and others, was taken up for consideration.

Mr. Teackle moved to amend the first section of the bill, by striking out in the 10th line, the word "eight," and insert in lieu thereof, the word "ten."

Mr. Ely called for a division of the question, and it was put on striking out. Determined in the negative.

On motion by Mr. M'Mahon, said section was amended, by inserting after the word "clerk," in the 20th line thereof, the words "in writing, and by him to be filed."

On motion by Mr. Hughlett, the 6th section of the bill was stricken out.

On motion by Mr. Burchenal, the following was inserted in lieu of the sixth section, stricken out:

"Sec. 6. And be it enacted, That if any person or persons shall be found trading or vending any goods, as expressed by the provisions of this act, or the act to which this is a supplement, without first obtaining a license as required by this act, shall on conviction thereof, forfeit and pay to the clerk of the county for the use of the state, not exceeding the sum of fifty dollars, nor less than the price of the license, in the discretion of the court before whom the same may be tried."

Mr. Amos moved to amend said bill by adding the following as an additional section to the bill:

"And be it enacted, That the proviso contained in the third section of the original act to which this is a supplement, be and the same is hereby repealed."
