Mr. Steele moved to fill the blank with "five hundred."

On the question being put, on filling the blank with "five hundred," it was determined in the negative.

Mr. Smith moved to fill the blank with "three hundred and fifty." Resolved in the affirmative.

On motion by Mr. Teackle, said bill was further amended, by adding at the end of said section, the following proviso: "Provided, that previously to receiving any compensation under this act, the said Adjutant General shall relinquish all claim upon the state for past services in that department, and that any act or resolution which might be construed to authorise any such demand, be and the same is hereby repealed or rescinded.
