When Mr. Turner moved to amend the last resolution, by adding at the end thereof, the following proviso: "Provided always, that the whole expense to be incurred in obtaining the information, and making the surveys and estimates directed by the foregoing resolutions, shall not exceed one thousand dollars, and that no appointment shall be made by the governor and council to execute any of the duties required by the said resolutions, until they shall be satisfied that the whole expense will not exceed that amount."

Mr. Steele moved to postpone said preamble and resolutions, indefinitely.

On the question being put, it was resolved in the affirmative.
