The clerk of the senate returned the bill, entitled, A supplement to the act, entitled, *An act to enable the purchasers to obtain possession of lands and premises sold by sheriffs, coroners and elisors, at public auction, passed December session 1825, chapter 103, endorsed, "will pass."* Ordered to be engrossed. Also the bill, entitled, *An act to divorce Charity Alderson and William C. Alderson;* also the bill, entitled, *An act for the benefit of Asahel Hussey and others;* also the bill, entitled, *An act to brand mackerel fish, and to reduce the rate of inspecting the same in the city of Baltimore, severally endorsed, "will pass with the proposed amendments;"* which amendments were severally read the first, and by special order the second time, assented to, and the bills ordered to be engrossed. Also the bill, entitled, *An act requiring the commissioners of Harford county, to open the road therein mentioned, endorsed "will pass with the proposed amendment;"* which amendment was twice read and dissented from. Also the bill, entitled, *An act further supplemental to the act of December session 1827, chapter 111, entitled, An act to regulate sales by public auction;* also, the bill, entitled, *An act to authorise the appointment of commissioners without the state, to administer oaths and take acknowledgments of deeds, severally endorsed, "will not pass."* Also the resolution authorising the register of the land office for the western shore to receive into the land office a certificate of a tract of land called "*Stewart's Good Will,*" and issue a patent for the same to *Mary Magrath, endorsed "assented to."* Ordered to be engrossed. Also the resolution in favour of *Mary Simpson, of Allegany county, endorsed, "dissented from."* And delivered the following message:
