Mr. Edelen, submitted the following resolution.

Resolved, by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the treasurer of the western shore, be and he is hereby authorised to pay Raphael C. Edelen, for the use of Benjamin Goddard, of Prince George's county, only child and representative of John Goddard, of said county, a revolutionary soldier, who died on the second day of September, last past, sixteen dollars and eighty nine cents, it being the amount due him at the time of his death, as a pensioner.

Which was read the first and second time by special order, and assented to.

On motion by Mr. Harper,

Ordered, That the treasurer of the western shore be directed to report to this house, at as earlier day as possible, what instalments have been paid on the part of this state to the Chesapeake and Ohio Canal Company, and to the Baltimore and Ohio Rail Road Company, since the passage of the acts incorporating those companies;—also what instalments on the state's stock in those companies are now due, or likely to fall due in the current year;—also whether he has received proof according to the acts of 1827, chapter 104, and 1829 chapter 200, that instalments similar to those required of the state, have been paid by individual and other stockholders, agreeably to the condition of subscription contained in the acts of 1827 chapters 104 and 105;—and also what amount he has received from the said companies respectively, for dividends on stock held by the state.

And Mr. Cottman, reported a bill, entitled, an act to confirm an act, entitled, An act to amend the Constitution and
