

Ennalls Martin, of Talbot county, a surgeon's mate in the revolutionary war; accompanied with the following resolutions:—

Resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Barbara Reily, of the District of Columbia, widow of the late Major Wm. Reily, a soldier of the revolutionary war, or to her order, during widowhood, in half yearly payments, a sum of money equal to the half pay of a captain, in consideration of the services rendered by her husband during said war.

Resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Dr. Ennalls Martin, of Talbot county, a surgeon's mate during the revolutionary war, or to his order, in half yearly payments, a sum of money, equal to the half pay of a surgeon's mate, in consideration of the services rendered by him during said war.

Which were severally read the first time, and, ordered to lie on the table.

The Clerk of the Senate delivered a bill, originated in and passed by the Senate, entitled, An act to incorporate the Franklin Savings Company of Baltimore; which was read and referred to Messrs. Harper, Jenkins and Turner.

Also, a communication from Thomas Culbreth, clerk of the council, enclosing an account of the expenditures and disbursements of the Executive of Maryland, for the year 1832; submitted to the General Assembly, in pursuance of a resolution of December session, 1830; referred by the Senate to the consideration of this house.

Which was read, and referred to the committee on Ways and Means.

Also, delivered a letter from the 'hon. James Thomas, the Governor elect; referred by the Senate to the consideration of this house. Which letter was read, and is as follows:—
