

The bill reported by Mr. Pratt, entitled, An act to repeal an act, entitled, An act respecting the Equity Jurisdiction of the County Courts, in the first Judicial District of Maryland, passed at December session, 1831, chapter 309; was taken up for consideration, read the second time, and rejected.

The hour having arrived for taking up the order of the day, the house proceeded to consider the report of the joint committee, on the South Carolina Ordinance, and the substitute proposed by Mr. Merrick.

Mr. Blakistone moved to amend the first resolution, by striking out, in the last line, the words "expostulate mildly and affectionately," and insert in lieu thereof, the words "reason coolly and dispassionately."

Mr. Forman moved to lay the report and resolutions on the table, and make them the order of the day for Monday next.

Resolved in the affirmative.

Mr. Jenkins reported a bill, entitled, An act to authorize the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore to alter the width of a part of Canal, formerly Harford-street; of a part of Spring-street; of a part of Strawberry alley, and to close Russell Lane.

Which was read the first time, and ordered to lie on the table.

On motion by Mr. Harper, the Speaker appointed Mr. Cottman, on the Committee on Internal Improvement, to supply the vacancy occasioned by the absence of Mr. Dennis.

The house adjourned until Tomorrow morning, ten o'clock.

SATURDAY, January 19th, 1833.

The house met. Present the same members as on yesterday. The proceedings of yesterday were read.

Mr. Jenkins presented a petition of Thomas Baltzell and others, praying the passage of an act to incorporate the Chatsworth water company, in the city of Baltimore, which was read and referred to Messrs. Jenkins, Harper and Worthington.

Mr. Edelen presented a petition of Stephen Fennell, of Brown county, State of Ohio, praying to be placed on the pension roll of this State;

And Mr. Teackle presented a memorial of Anna M. Smith, widow of Major Thomas Smith, of the revolutionary army, praying for an increase of pension;
