Mr. Heard, from the Select Committee, to whom was referred so much of the Executive message, as relates to the Inspection of Tobacco, delivered the following report:—

The select committee raised by an order of the House of Delegates, and to whom was referred all that part of the Executive message, which relates to the inspection of Tobacco, beg leave to report:—

That they have given the subject the consideration which its importance and the magnitude of the interest involved in it required. In the course of their investigations they have ascertained that prior to the passage of the resolution, No. twenty-one, of December session, eighteen hundred and thirty-one, by which the charge for cooperage was abolished: that the state had appropriated to its current expenses, the sum of thirty-five thousand, four hundred and thirty-six dollars, and thirty cents, out of the funds which had been received into the Treasury, on account of
