Also, a bill, entitled, an act to incorporate "the Baltimore Eastern Savings Company; which was read and referred to Messrs. Jenkins, Harper and Turner.

Mr. Turner reported a bill, entitled, an act for the relief of William C. Weatherby, of Baltimore county.

Mr. Forwood reported a bill, entitled, an act for building a bridge across the Little Falls of Gunpowder near Baldwin's mills; which were read the first time and ordered to lie on the table.

The Speaker laid before the house a report from the Treasurer of the Western Shore, in obedience to an order of the house of the 3rd inst. relative to the aggregate amount of revenue paid into the Treasury by each county, the city of Baltimore, and the city of Annapolis, as nearly as can be ascertained; and the amount disbursed to each respectively, for the years 1828, '29, '30, '31 and '32, ending 30th November 1832; which was read; and,

On motion by Mr. Johnson, five hundred copies ordered to be printed.

On motion by Mr. Jones, (seconded by two other members who voted in the majority) the house reconsidered their vote upon the unfavourable report of the committee on pensions and revolutionary claims, upon the petition of Levin Willin, of Somerset county.

On motion by Mr. Jenkins, said report was laid on the table.

The bill reported by Mr. Heard, entitled, an act to authorize Clement McWilliams, of Saint Mary's county, to bring certain slaves into this State, was taken up for consideration; when,

On motion by Mr. Nicols, said bill was referred to the committee on the coloured population.

On motion by Mr. Harris, the house took up for consideration the bill reported by him, entitled, an act to repeal an act, entitled, an act for the relief of Joseph Stone, and others, securities of William Williams, late sheriff and collector of Saint Mary's county, passed December session 1831, chapter 210, and for other purposes.

On motion by Mr. Harris, said bill was amended by adding at the end thereof, the following proviso:

"Provided also, that the said Joseph Stone, administrator as aforesaid, or the agent whom he may appoint as aforesaid, shall not be entitled to receive poundage fee for
