

in and to the land mentioned and described therein; which was read and referred to the committee on grievances and courts of justice;

And Mr. Holmes presented a petition of sundry citizens of Baltimore county, praying that no division of said county may be made in relation to the proposed new county, to be styled Westminster county; which was read and referred to the committee already appointed on that subject.

The Speaker laid before the house a report of the Trustees of the Manchester United Academy or school in Baltimore county; which was read and referred to the committee on education.

Mr. Grove obtained leave to bring in a bill, entitled, a supplement to an act, entitled, an act passed at December session 1802, chapter 81, so far as relates to Washington county.

Ordered, That Messrs. Grove, Mann and Weast, report the same.

Mr. Powell obtained leave to bring in a bill to be entitled, an act to incorporate the Somerset and Worcester Rail Road Company.

Ordered, That Messrs. Powell, Teackle and Hearn, report the same.

On motion by Mr. Johnson,

Ordered, That John Buchanan and Revetdy Johnson, esqs. report to this General Assembly, and at as early a day as practicable, the Constitution of this State, as prepared by them, by virtue of the ninety-fifth resolution of December session 1825; and further ordered; that the Speaker of this House forthwith communicate this order by mail to each of those gentlemen.

Mr. Johnson, chairman of the committee on the militia, reported a bill, entitled, An act to enroll, organize, equip, and regulate the militia by amending and reducing into one the several acts of the General Assembly in relation thereto.

Mr. Mann reported a bill, entitled, An act to repeal an act, to declare certain trespasses felony, and for other purposes, passed at December session, 1826, chapter 260, so far as it relates to Washington county.

Mr. Ely reported a bill, entitled, An act to authorise the recording of certain deeds therein mentioned, and for other purposes;

And, Mr. Grove reported a bill, entitled, An act to incorporate the Town of Sharpsburgh, and Miller's Addition to Sharpsburgh.
