On motion by Mr. Heard,

Ordered, That so much of the Executive message, as relates to the Tobacco Inspection ware-houses, of the city of Baltimore, be referred to a select committee of seven, to be appointed by the chair.

Mr. Franklin Smith submitted the following order, which

was read the first time, and ordered to lie on the table.

Ordered, That so much of the Executive message as relates to the controversy between this state and the state of Virginia, on the subject of the unsettled western boundary of this state, be referred to a select committee, to consist of seven members, with instructions to report what course it now becomes the dignity of this state to pursue.

The House then adjourned until to-morrow morning 10

o'clock.

FRIDAY, January 3d, 1834.

The House met. Present the same members as on yes-

terday. The proceedings of yesterday were read.

Mr. Lantz presented a petition of Anne Postlewait, praying to be placed on the pension list for past and unpaid revolutionary services, rendered by her deceased husband, Samuel Postlewait.

Mr. Smith of Worcester, presented a petition of Patsy Blake, widow of John Blake, late of Worcester county, a soldier of the revolutionary war, praying for a continuation of the pension allowed to her deceased husband.

Mr. Larrimore presented a petition of Nathan Allen, of Queen Anne's county, a soldier of the revolutionary war,

praying for a pension;

Which were severally read and referred to the committee on pensions and revolutionary claims, to be hereafter appointed.

Mr. Smith of Worcester presented a petition of Maria

Berry, of Worcester county, praying for support;

Which was read and referred to the committee on pensions by county assessment.

Mr. Lantz presented a petition of Joseph Roberts, of Allegany county, praying for a special act of insolvency;

Which was read and referred to the committee on insol-

vency, to be hereafter appointed.

Mr. Harris presented a petition of sundry citizens of Saint Mary's county, praying for a change in the law establishing a school fund;
