for the purpose of general information, and that the public may more fully know the proceedings of the General Assembly, that at the request in writing addressed to the public printers of the two houses of the legislature, by the editors of newspapers or public journals in this state, who may desire the same for publication, to have every day of the session, forwarded a copy of the printed journals of proceedings of the senate, and house of delegates.

Mr. Palmer asked for the following leave:—

Leave to bring in a bill to be entitled, An act to authorise and call a Convention of Delegates, to alter and amend the present Constitution of Maryland;

Which was read, and after some discussion thereon, was postponed, the hour having arrived for taking up the order

of the day.

The House according to the order of the day, took up for consideration the message submitted by Mr. Brewer, on the 31st of December last, relative to the public printing, together with the order submitted by Mr. Crabb, on the same subject.
