Were severally taken up for consideration, read the second time and passed.

Mr. Carter of Montgomery, reported a bill, entitled, a supplement to the act, entitled, an act to lay out and open a road in Montgomery and Frederick counties, passed at December session eighteen hundred and thirty one, chap. thirty nine.

Which was read the first and second time by special order, and passed.

Mr. Snowden, reported a bill, entitled, a supplement to the act, to provide for the Public Instruction of Youth, in Primary Schools, throughout this state.

And, Mr. Peregoy reported a bill, entitled, an act to incorporate the Washington Beneficial Society, of Baltimore.

Which were severally read the first time and ordered to lie on the table.

The house then adjourned, until to-morrow morning 11 o'clock.

FRIDAY, January 17th, 1834.

The House met. Present the same members as on yesterday. The proceedings of yesterday were read.

The bill, entitled, an act to authorise appraisers on Real and Personal Estate, to qualify each other;

The bill, entitled, an act to amend the Constitution and Form of Government, as it relates to the division of Somerset county, into election districts, and to establish an additional election district;

The bill, entitled, an act to provide for the appointment of certain commissioners in Somerset county;
