

Ordered that Messrs. Peregoy, Jones of Baltimore City and Carroll report the same.

Mr. Unkefer obtained leave to bring in a bill to be entitled, an act to repeal certain parts of an act relating to the people of colour in this state, passed at December session, 1831, chapter 281, and impose a tax upon each slave brought into this state, to be applied to the benefit of the Maryland Colonization Society;

Ordered that Messrs. Unkefer, Bruff and Heard report the same.

Mr. Dulany obtained leave to bring in a bill to be entitled, an act relative to the introduction of slaves into this state acquired by marriage;

Ordered that Messrs. Dulany, Fassitt and Humrickhouse report the same.

On motion by Mr. Pratt, the House proceeded to take up for consideration the bill from the Senate, entitled an act to alter and change the name of the Corporation, known by the name of "The President and Directors of the Susquehanna Bridge and Bank Company."

Mr. Pratt moved to amend said bill by adding at the end thereof, the following words, "as prescribed in the original act of incorporation."

Resolved in the affirmative.

Mr. Pratt moved further to amend said bill, by adding the following as an additional section.

Sec. 2d. *And be it further enacted*, That nothing here in contained, shall be so construed as to prevent the issuing of a writ of scire facias or quo warranto, on the part of the state, to forfeit the charter of said company, if any act shall be ascertained to have been committed which would forfeit the said charter.

Resolved in the affirmative.

The said bill was then read a second time and passed with the proposed amendments.

Mr. Ely reported a bill, entitled, an act to prevent partiality in sales by auction of deceased persons estates.

Mr. Burchenal reported a bill, entitled, an act to extend real estate.

And Mr. Evans reported a bill, entitled, an act to build a bridge over North East Creek, near North East, in Cecil county, on the Main road, leading from North East to Charles Town;

Which were severally read the first time and ordered to lie on the table.
